

CHARITABLE DONATION TAX CREDIT

The Charitable Donation Tax Credit is designed to make doing something good even better.

At the end of the year, you will get a combined Federal and Provincial tax credit of about 23% of your first \$200 of charitable donations. For amounts over \$200, you get a combined Federal and Provincial tax credit of 43.7%.
